

# Baby Blocks

Finished Size 36" x 48"

## Materials needed:

Fabric allowance allows for shrinkage if you wash, dry & iron all fabric before cutting.

WOF = width of fabric

1/3 yd each of 6 different prints      From each print, cut two 6 1/2" squares, four 3 1/2 x 6 1/2" rectangles and four 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles (refer to cutting diagram)

1/2 yard for binding      Cut 5 - 2 1/4" x WOF strips for binding

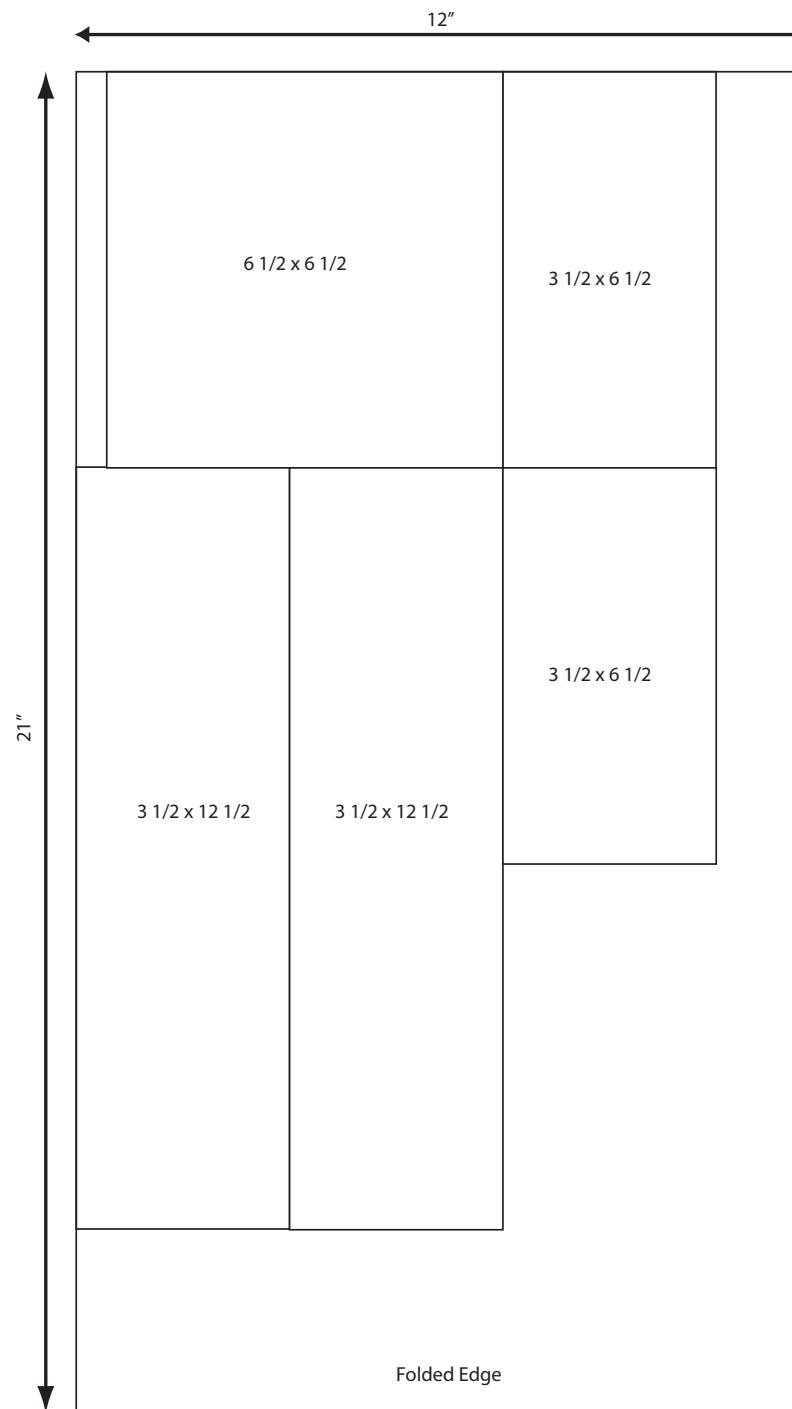
1 1/2 yards for backing

42" x 54" quilt batting

## Assemble the quilt top:

**Note:** A 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout.

1. For each block you will need one 6-1/2" square, and two 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" and two 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" contrasting rectangles.
2. Stitch 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to opposite sides of 6-1/2" square; press seams towards outer edge.  
Stitch 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles to top and bottom of block; press seams towards outer edge.  
Block should measure 12 1/2" square (make 12).
4. Arrange blocks in any manner pleasing to you, and stitch together in rows. Stitch rows together to complete quilt.
5. Quilt & bind as desired.
